- Format:** A 5K (3.1 mile) fundraising walk and a 5K (3.1 mile) run through the scenic trails of Thompson Park and New York State Zoo.
- AIDS Community Resources:** AIDS Community Resources (ACR), a not-for-profit 501(c)3 organization, was founded in 1983. Its mission is three-fold:  
-To prevent the spread of HIV and other sexually transmitted diseases;  
-To provide support services to those who are living with HIV/AIDS; and  
-To promote sexual literacy and improved medical outcomes.
- Where the Money Goes:** **Teen AIDS Task Force (TATF):** This teen-centered peer leadership program focuses on topics such as self-esteem, healthy relationships, drug and alcohol prevention, healthy nutrition, and promotion of sexual health and safety. This program reaches more than 5500 youths per year.
- Emergency/Basic/Human Needs:** An ongoing stabilization initiative that provides HIV-infected individuals and their families with food, personal care items, household items, and clothing during critical times.
